



How about joining the RAL table tennis box leagues?

(existed since September 2006)

The main objective of the league is to provide social exchange between players of similar standard.

General Information

- Players are grouped according to their standard of play and approximately 6-10 players will be assigned to each box.
- Match results are sent to a league administrator and at the end of a play period the results from your box are sent to you together with the names and contact details of the players in your new box.

Free entry!

Play Period

In the 2-3 month play period you play as many of the other players in your box as you can.

Box League Scoring

The winner of a box league match gets 3 points and the loser gets 1 point. No points are given for matches that were not played. To compare, 3 loses equals one win. At the end of a play period about 2 players will go up to the next box and about 2 players will go down. The aim of the scoring system is to try to ensure that over time each box consists of players of similar standard players and each player gets to play different players in different Play Periods.
